






THE FCC CONSTRUCCIÓN GROUP IN FIGURES (million euro)


TURNOVER BY THE FCC GROUP





TURNOVER AND BACKLOG BY GEOGRAPHICAL AREA (million euro)




TURNOVER AND BACKLOG BY WORK TYPE (million euro)


GENERATION OF WEALTH 2008 FCC CONSTRUCCIÓN GROUP





Family Plan


FCC and the Adecco Foundation signed onto this plan in 2007, in their quest for the ongoing improvement of conditions for FCC employee relatives with disabilities.




OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY INDICATORS


DEVELOPMENT OF THE INCIDENCE INDEX



RECYCLED/USED MATERIALS FCC CONSTRUCCIÓN

FCC Construcción engages in an ongoing effort to keep excavation material from ending up in landfills.

A total of 24,183,012 m³ of earth and/or rock left over from excavation and 88,213 m³ of clean rubble have been used on site and therefore considered raw materials, instead of having to be managed as waste and hauled to a landfill.

SUSTAINABLE CONSTRUCTION

We participate in and sometimes lead a number of different international, European and national working groups in connection with sustainable construction.

FCC Construcción coordinates the "Sustainability in Civil Works" working group on the ISO/TC-59/SC17 International Technical Committee on "Sustainability in Building Construction". FCC Construcción is also on the Committee's other working groups.

At the European level, we are on Committee CEN/TC-350, "Sustainability of Construction Works". We are also on the Spanish mirror committee, Committee AEN/CTN 198, "Sustainable Construction", where we also chair Subcommittee SC2, "Sustainability in Civil Works".

We are also on the "Sustainable Construction" working group of the Entorno Foundation, where we helped put together the publication

"Construimos Valor. Incentivos a la Construcción Sostenible" ("We Build Value: Incentive for Sustainable Construction"), which proposes incentives to foster sustainability in construction, including six lines of action.

ETHICS

■ FCC updates its code of ethics

The FCC Group has developed its new Code of Ethics, approved by the Board of Directors on 10 June 2008, with the goal of unifying and reinforcing the identity, culture and patterns of conduct of the Group. The Code is a compass to orient and steer FCC's actions in social, environmental and ethical matters.

This initiative is one way FCC honours the commitments to social responsibility and transparency that it made when it joined the UN Global Compact and when it established its Corporate Social Responsibility Master Plan.

The ethical principles stated in the Code pertain to all directors, executives and employees of the companies in the FCC Group, and they must be obeyed.

The Code stipulates that all employees can report actions or conduct inappropriate in the light of the Code's principles over the Group's Intranet, confidentially and without any fear of reprisals.

DIALOGUE AND INFORMATION TRANSPARENCY

Two-way channels of communication are kept open so we are in non-stop contact with our interest groups, to discover their information needs and expectations.

FCC Construcción's website is www.fcco.es. In 2008 the design and contents were completely overhauled to make the site easier to browse, and with an eye to double-AA accessibility criteria.

The e-bulletin. Our newsletter is available on line in Spanish and English. Subscription service is available. In 2008 11 issues were published.


